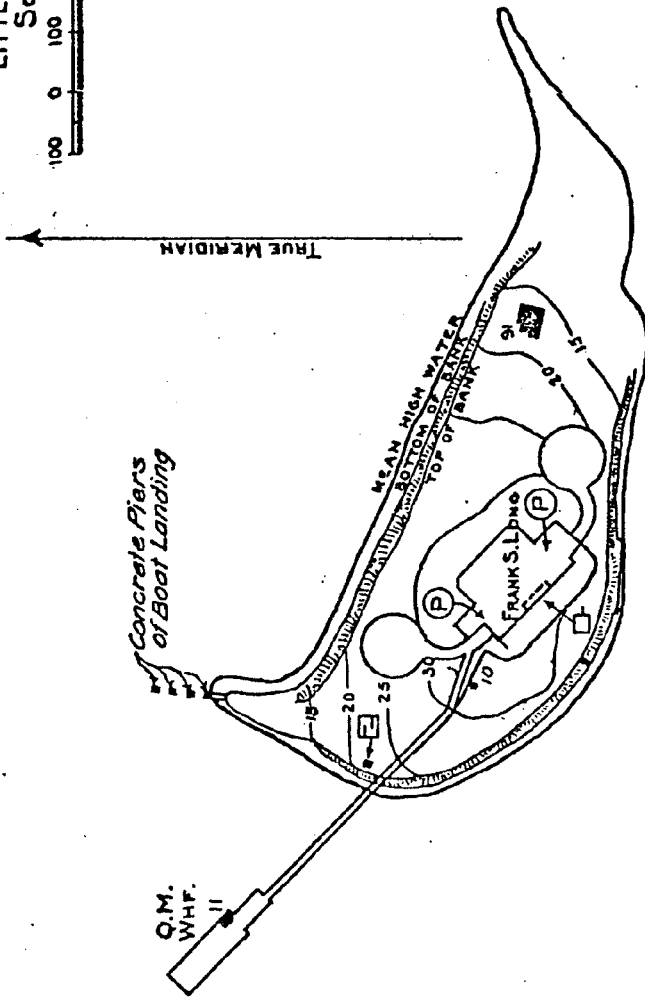
LITTLE HOG ISLAND
