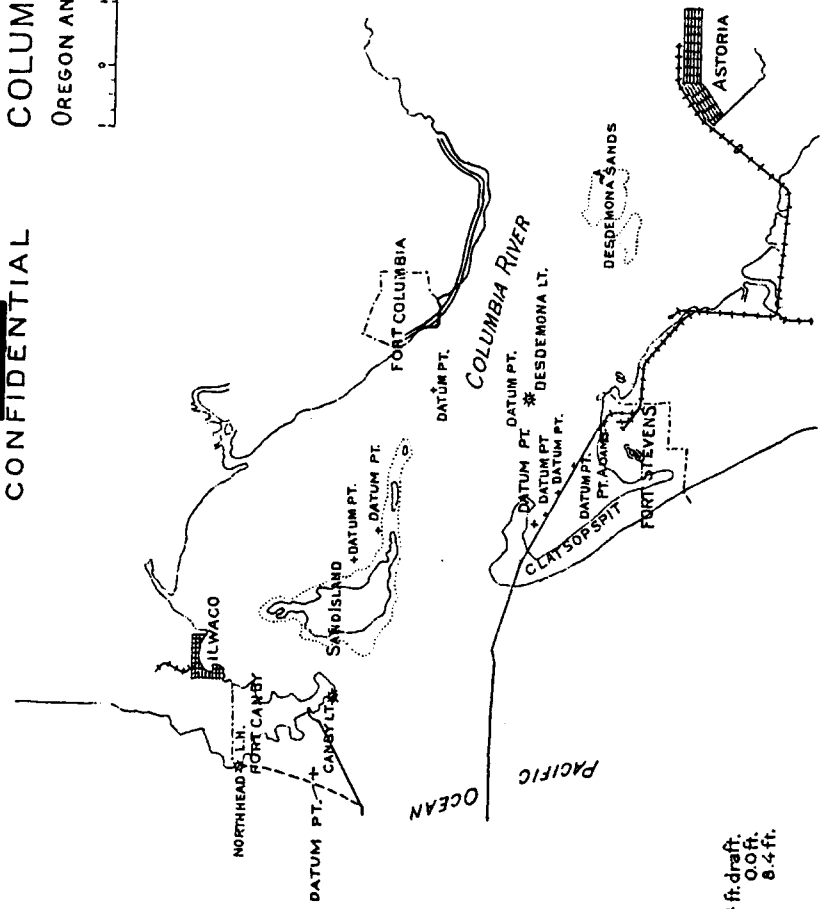
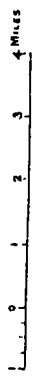

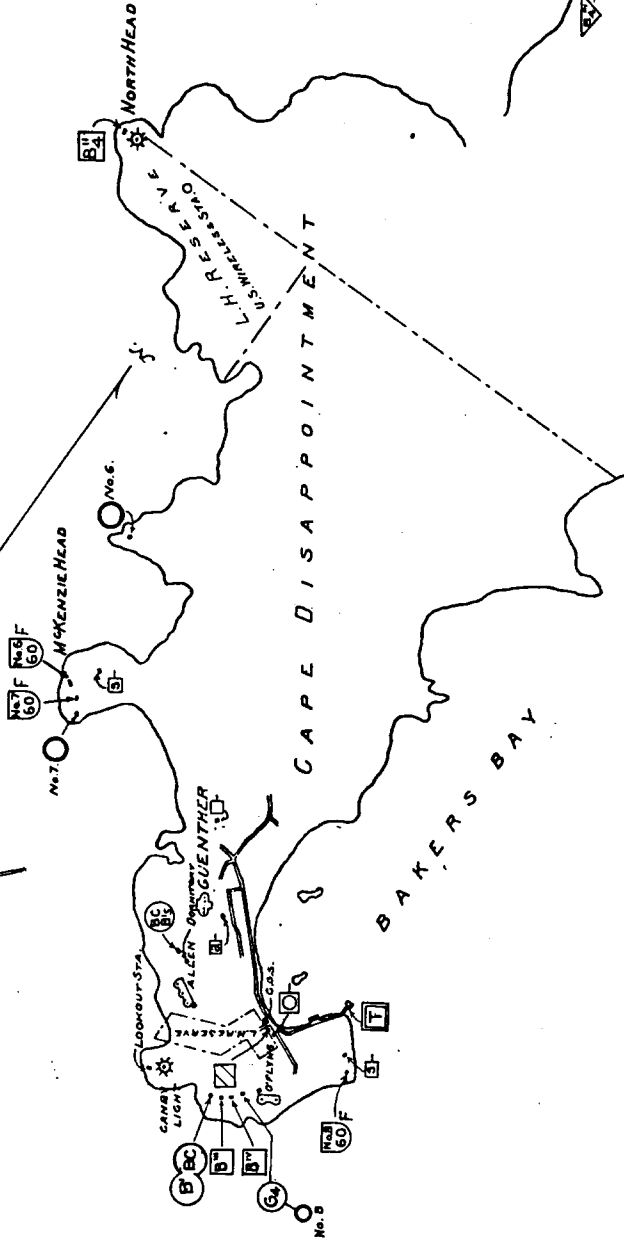
GENERAL MAP

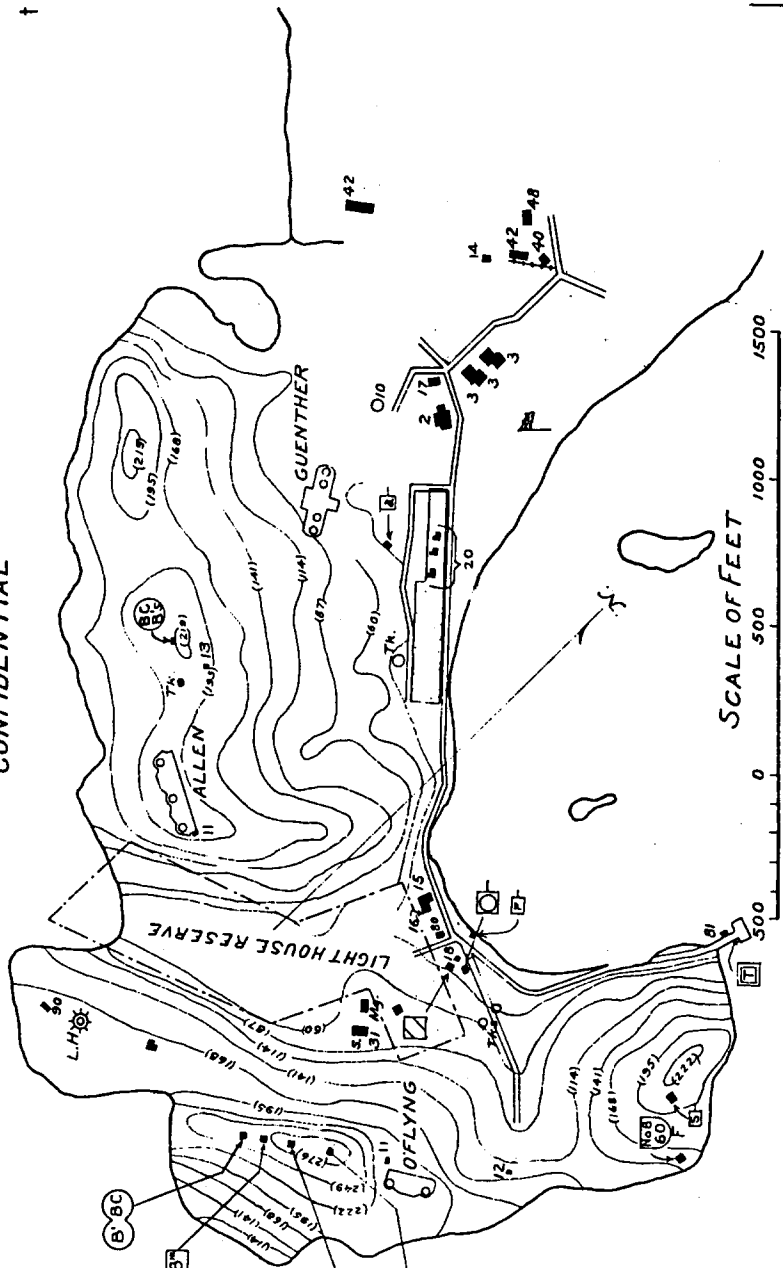
