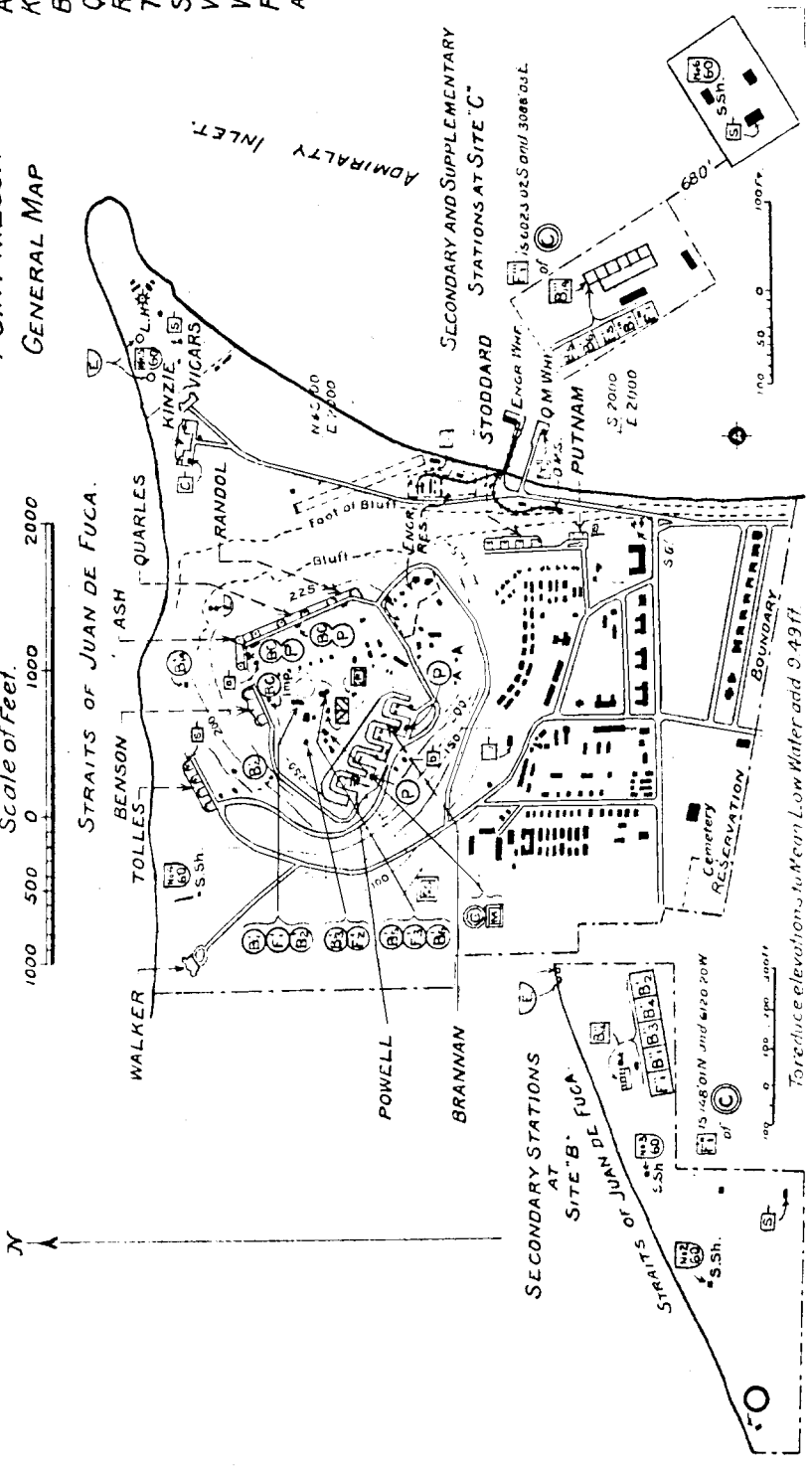
PUGET SOUND FORT WORDEN POINT WILSON GENERAL MAP

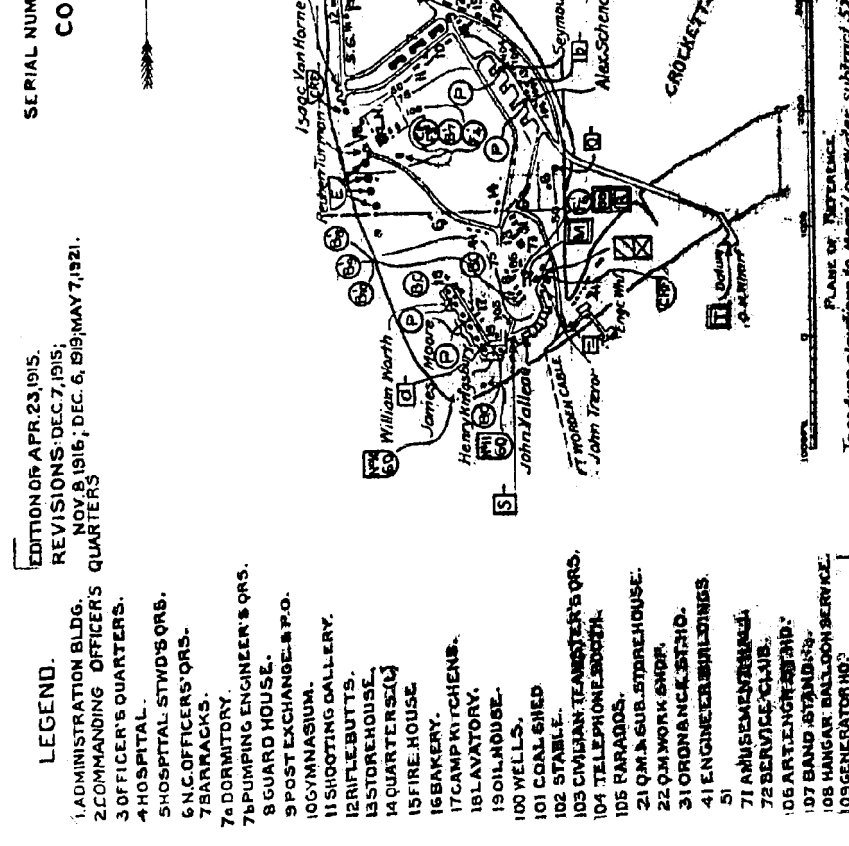
