

Coast Defense Study Group 2025 Annual Conference to the Harbor Defenses of Boston 23-27 April 2025 First Announcement – Seven Months Out

Throughout its history, Boston Harbor held a strategic importance in wartime. First the British and later the United States government built military outposts and forts across the Boston Harbor Islands to prevent an attack from the sea. During the 1800s and 1900s, the US military continued to update forts in alignment with new advancements in defense systems and technologies. During WWII and the Cold War, more defenses were built to protect Boston from attack. From behind imposing walls or protecting casemates, the heavy guns of the island forts overlooked the harbor and protected it for over a century. The CDSG Conference will cover all the major fortifications (except for Nahant which was visited during our annual conference to Portsmouth), many that are on islands that are difficult to visit except by attending our conference. The tentative schedule, subject to weather and permissions to visit is:

- Wednesday, April 23 check in 4pm at Nantasket Beach Resort.
- Thursday, April 24 (by DCR boat) Fort Standish, Great & Outer Brewster Islands.
- Friday, April 25 (by DCR boat) Forts Andrews, Strong, Warren.
- Saturday, April 26 (by car) Forts Independence, Banks, Revere, Duvall; banquet & business meeting.
- Sunday, April 27 (by car) Fourth Cliff MR, Scituate, MA, other south sites; Conference ends. PM (optional) Tour the USS Salem at Quincy, MA.
- Monday, April 28 (optional) Drive to Newport, RI to tour Fort Adams.

The conference registration cost is \$125. As in the past, our conferences are self-supporting. The registration cost covers the meeting room, banquet, and a few other expenses. We are not providing meals except for the banquet, and breakfast is not available at the hotel. The hotel rooms have refrigerators. You are responsible for travel to/from the conference, ground transportation, and lodging. The conference hotel selected is the Nantasket Beach Resort (45 Hull Shore Dr, Hull, MA, 02045). We selected this hotel because it is near the Massachusetts Department of Conservation & Recreation (DCR) support center for the Boston Harbor Islands at Hingham, MA.

We have reserved block of 40 rooms. The hotel room rates we have arranged are:

- One king bed (10 rooms in block) WE-TH \$99/night; FR-SA \$199/night.
- Two queen beds (14 rooms in block) WE-TH \$99/night; FR-SA \$199/night
- One king bed with ocean view (8 rooms in block) WE-TH \$109/night; FR-SA \$249/night

• Two queen beds with ocean view (8 rooms in block) – WE-TH \$109/night; FR-SA \$249/night In addition to the room costs above, there is an occupancy tax of 9.7%, and a hotel amenity fee of \$18 per room per night. These room rates are available through **March 15, 2025, or until the reserved block of rooms is filled**. Hotel rooms may be available after that date but at much higher rate.
